

# STX/IL National High School Lacrosse Final Rankings

Baltimore, Md.- Inside Lacrosse has released its final STX/Inside Lacrosse National High School Rankings for 2007.

West Islip (NY) garnered the top spot in the rankings, posting a 22-1 record and winning the New York Class A state title. Loyola (MD), was No. 2, followed by West Genesee (NY), Georgetown Prep (MD) and Jamesville-DeWitt (NY), which rocketed into the top five after beating John Jay (no. 7) for the NY Class B State Championship.

**Several teams just recently moved into the top 25, including Shoreham-Wading River (NY).** In all, New York leads the way with ten teams in the top 25. Maryland and Pennsylvania tie for second with four teams apiece. New Jersey has three teams represented in the rankings. Connecticut, California, Massachusetts and Ohio have one team each.

The most surprising part of the year came at the end, as several teams who were ranked very highly all year fell after stumbling in the playoffs.

Huntington (NY), ranked No. 1 all season long, lost to John Jay in its state semifinals. John Jay lost to Jamesville-DeWitt in the state final causing Huntington to tumble to eighth. Delbarton (NJ), ranked in the top five all season, lost to Mountain Lakes (NJ) in its final game of the season. Downingtown East (PA) also performed well in the playoffs and finished the season at No. 11.

St. Ignatius Prep (CA) finished its season undefeated and at No. 23 in the final high school rankings, marking the first time a California team finished the season ranked in the top 25.

The STX/Inside Lacrosse National High School Rankings came out each week during the spring.
