

Quinnipiac University senior defender John Donnellan (Shoreham, N.Y.) has earned All-Great Western Lacrosse League honors, as it was announced today by the league office. One of the stalwarts of the Quinnipiac defensive unit for four years, Donnellan was named Second-Team All-GWLL. **He is also a 2006 COSIDA Academic All-America nominee for his efforts both on the field and in the classroom.**

Donnellan started all 13 games for the Bobcats in 2006 and was a key reason why the club finished with a winning record (7-6). Quinnipiac also enjoyed a respectable showing in its first year as a member of the GWLL, including its first-ever league win against Butler on April 29.

Donnellan finished third on the club with 42 groundballs in 2006.

This marks the third time during Donnellan's career that he has been honored by a league for his performance. As a freshman, he was named to the America East All-Rookie Team. Last year, he picked up All-America East Second-Team honors.

Donnellan is also an All-New England nominee and an East-West game nominee.
